Supriya Sen is an occupational therapy educator and clinician with academic and practice experience in both Australia and the United States. She earned her Doctor of Occupational Therapy from University of Illinois Chicago in 2013, a Master of Science in Ergonomics from La Trobe University in 1990, and a Bachelor of Occupational Therapy with a double major in Psychology from The University of Queensland in 1987.

She currently serves as an Associate Clinical Professor in the School of Occupational Therapy at Texas Woman's University, where she has worked since 2021. Her professional background includes experience in occupational therapy education, work rehabilitation, ergonomics, fieldwork education, and mentorship of future practitioners.

Since relocating to Texas, Supriya has remained active in the Texas occupational therapy community through conference participation, presentations, and professional service with Texas Occupational Therapy Association, including work as a continuing education reviewer since 2024. She also serves as secretary for the Texas Doctoral Capstone Coordinator Consortium and has participated in professional organizations including AOTA, WFOT, and the American Congress of Rehabilitation Medicine.
